Petitioner has filed a Motion for *pro hac vice* admission of Mr. Grant E. Kinsel. Paper 29 (“Motion” or “Mot.”).² Petitioner also attached an affidavit of Mr. Kinsel in support of its Motion. *Id.* at 4–6. Patent Owner has not opposed the Motion. *Id.* at 2.

We have reviewed the Motion and the accompanying affidavit of Mr. Kinsel. The affidavit fails to show that Mr. Kinsel is familiar with the subject matter at issue in the proceeding or if he has applied to appear *pro hac vice* in other proceedings. *See Unified Patents v. Parallel Iron*, Case IPR2013-00639 (PTAB Oct. 15, 2013) (setting forth the requirements for *pro hac vice* admission) (Paper 7). Petitioner’s Motion is *denied*.

ORDERED that Petitioner’s Motion for *pro hac vice* admission of Mr. Grant E. Kinsel is *denied*.
